

Ian Roebuck 29.1.1936 - 18.2.2024



Ian lived in Mottram, at various addresses on Broadbottom Road, for the whole of his life. He discovered his local church early and joined the choir in 1944, shortly after his 8th birthday.

Ian attended Mottram School and then Hyde Grammar School where he excelled, especially in art.

On leaving school he got a job as a clerk in the grandly titled "Mutual Life Philanthropic

Assurance Collecting Society". Employed there all his life, he worked his way up to be the very popular general manager.

Ian married Brenda, the love of his life, at Gee Cross Methodist Chapel in Hyde where Brenda was a member.

Ian was a PCC member for 70 years, and also PCC Secretary, Churchwarden, Sacristan and a chorister for almost 80 years. Ian began singing treble, then tenor and then finally base. He often sang solo, notably singing the tenor solo of "Olivet to Calvary' – despite the fact that he never learnt to read music! In 2019 he was presented with a Royal School of Church Music medal in recognition of 75 years of service.

Art was a major part of Ian's life – he designed and painted posters for church events, provided illustrations for publications and books, and cartoons for the church magazine, in which many of us have featured! (See p 16)

Larger than life – Ian was an entertainer, lighting up any room whether reciting poetry or as the dame in drag in the panto!

In 2011 Brenda passed away and it was both his family and church family and friends who supported Ian.

Ian will be remembered as a real gentleman, dedicated to any role he took on, and a proud father of his two boys. He was passionate, multitalented, colourful, much loved and will be sorely missed; yet we're sure he's now singing in that heavenly choir.





April is now back in glorious colour, so...





WANT TO SUPPORT BROADBOTTOM PRIMARY SCHOOL?

WHY NOT BECOME A TRUSTEE FOR THIS SMALL CHARITY?

Two more volunteers are needed for a few hours of their time a year to enable the smooth running of Broadbottom School Trust.

Broadbottom School Trust owns the land on which Broadbottom School stands – land which was given in 1896 and 1897 by Edward Chapman of Whitegates in trust as a school for the children of the village. The Trust also has a very small amount of capital money which is invested through Chester Diocese and provides about £100 per year for the benefit of the pupils.

There is provision for four Trustees (plus the current Vicar of Mottram Church as an ex-officio Trustee), and due to changes in personnel, we currently have two vacancies. The job of the Trustees is to ensure that the land continues to be used as a school, and to oversee the bank account to ensure that the income is used properly, in order to benefit the pupils of the school. There has been a recent spate of activity to bring the Trust up-to-date; usually, the work of the Trust involves two very short meetings each year.

The Trustees have no involvement with the running of the school or the quality of education provided.

The current Trustees are Claire Bibby (Chair) and Dorothy Stringer (Secretary). 


